## **SEASON 2011 KEY DATES**

### **JUNIORS**

- Junior Rugby sign on days are in the pipeline from mid-February onwards- in town clubs 12/13 February, Goondiwindi Jnrs 3 March – all other areas to be advised. An advertising campaign of WIN TV has been proposed;

- With the changes to the Junior Pathways, Come and Try days have been programmed to familiarise clubs with new rules – Dates will be confirmed in due course. Darling Downs Development Office from QRU is to attend and assist clubs.
- First Round for Juniors is to be 2<sup>nd</sup> April –We will have an opening carnival – Dalby have expressed an interest in hosting this.
- Season to finish in line with Seniors – we are trying to ensure minimum 15 rounds of rugby. This would include Opening Carnival, Grammar Carnival, Closing Carnival and 12 rounds of weekly rugby if calendar (and weather) permits.

### **TEENAGE**

- First term – Friday nights – Under 13/15/17 age groups. Sign on 11<sup>th</sup> February. Competition is to run for 6 wks commencing 25 February with finals to be 1 April (weather permitting). We will have a competition with grand final in each age group.
- Rep coaches are currently being appointed. It is anticipated that they will be viewing some of the Friday night games.
- Host venues and times to be determined once teams are nominated on 11 Feb. Looking for set times of 6pm, 7pm and 8pm - where sufficient fields available.

- ☺ Third term selection games and trial games for rep.

## SENIORS

- ☺ Proposed Competition Structure:-  
10 x A Grade teams with the elevation of Highfields. South Burnett will be combining with the Highfields Club and will be fielding a B Grade team. The contact at Highfields is Sean Andreas on 0415 261 092.

10 x B Grade teams with the elevation of South Burnett. The contact at South Burnett is Shane O'Malley on 0438 151 135.

6 x C Grade teams. This includes the addition of Chinchilla who will combine with the Dalby Club. The contact at Chinchilla is 0412 623 345.

7 x Under 19 teams.

- ☺ With 10 A grade teams, we propose to continue with the 5 team finals series.
- ☺ Games to start 2 April 2011 – Grand Final to be held 3 September – all games and finals will be finished prior to the start of the World Cup.
- ☺ Play through the season with only one break weekend – Easter.
- ☺ The final version of the draw is planned to be released by the Presidents' Meeting on 19 February. A draft version is currently being circulated amongst

those clubs that share their facilities to ensure no conflicts of dates.

## JUNIOR REDS

The 2011 Juniors Reds intake comprises 29 up and coming teenage footballers. The boys will get together for their first meeting at an induction session on 31 January. Marty Leggat in conjunction with Chris Lane of the ARU will coordinate and run the training sessions aided by Hamish Proctor and Grant Gleeson. From past experience this is an excellent programme for developing talent in our teenage ranks.

## DARLING DOWNS DEVELOPMENT OFFICER

It is great news that Queensland Rugby has decided to permanently base one of their Development Officers in Toowoomba. This will be an invaluable resource for all levels of rugby to have access to for the promotion and development of our great game. The Development Officer will be co-located with Downs Rugby at Anzac Central. Mr Lachlan Parkinson, who many of you know, has been transferred back to Brisbane to work as one of the QRU's coaching development staff. We wish Lachlan every success in his new role as he has served us well and has been a great advocate for rugby on the Downs over the years, particularly in the younger age groups where Lachlan demonstrated a great rapport with our future stars. We will be able to announce Lachlan's replacement shortly.
